

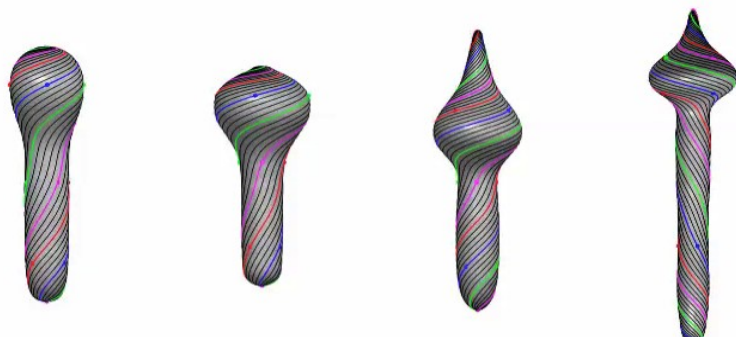
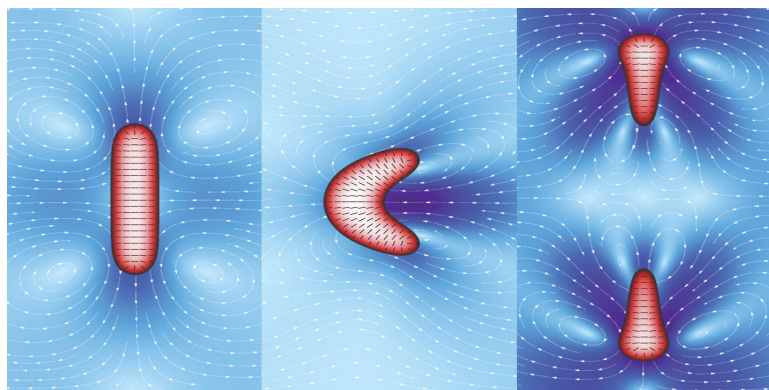
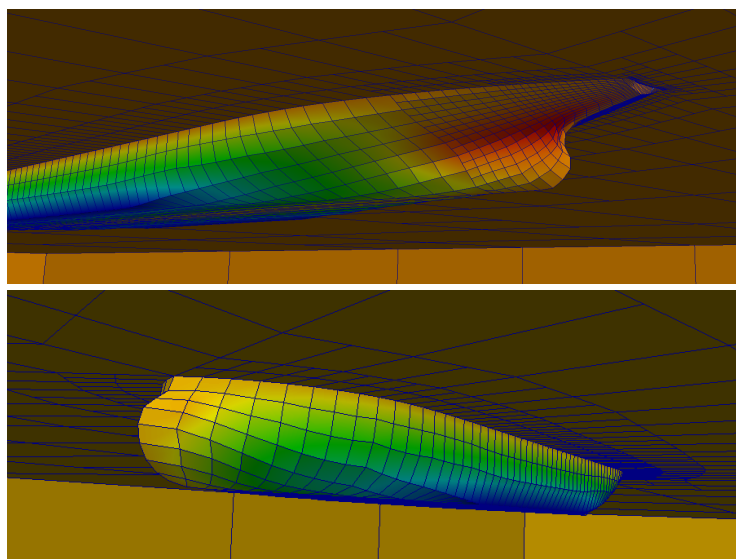
SISSA mathLab celebrates its first five years (2010 – 2015)

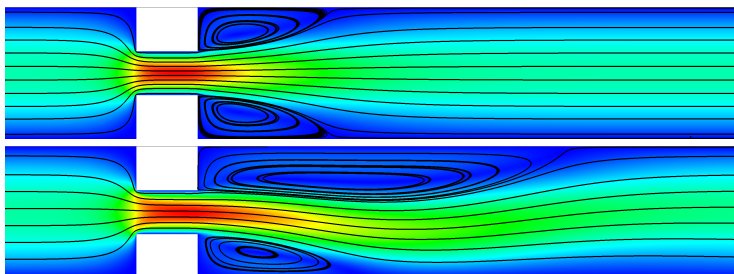
